Mark's Account

“Jesus then left that place and went into the region of Judea and across the Jordan. Again crowds of people came to him, and as was his custom, he taught them” (Mark 10:1).

Matthew's Account

“When Jesus had finished saying these things, he left Galilee and went into the region of Judea to the other side of the Jordan. Large crowds followed him, and he healed them there” (Matthew 19:1–2).

In addition to the teachings we also find in Matthew and Mark, Luke gives many accounts and details not found anywhere else. What are these unique incidents recorded only in Luke?
